CLASSES 2,4 & 6 OPEN TO ALL GRADES

CLASS 1: BE90

Open to Grade 4.

NB: FEI Ponies or Advanced Riders not eligible Maximum

height of fences: 0.90m (3'0")

Cross Country Speed: 375 mpm

1st Prize: £50 2nd: £25 3rd: £20

CLASS 2: BE90 OPEN

Open to all Grades.

Maximum height of fences: 0.9m (3'0")

Cross Country Speed: 400 mpm

1st Prize: £50 2nd: £25 3rd: £20

CLASS 3: BE100

Open to Grade 4. Minimum Eligibility Requirements are not required for this class

Maximum height of fences: 1.00m (3'3")

Cross Country Speed: 425 mpm

1st Prize: £50 2nd: £25 3rd: £20

CLASS 4: BE100OPEN

Open to all Grades.

Minimum Eligibility Requirements are not required for this class

Maximum height of fences: 1.00m (3'3")

Cross Country Speed: 450 mpm

Open to Grades 3 and 4.

Day Pass members are eligible for the discounted members rate.

- JAS Championship Prizes: training vouchers to the value of £500, £250 & £150 to 1st, 2nd, 3rd placed riders respectively Special prizes will also be provided by title sponsor Baileys.
- To enter the Championships, please enter as you would any other qualifier for the series; online or use a BE JAS entry form.
- If not a full current BE member, riders must have an Associate Registration and horses, a BE Equine Registration. These can be completed for free at www.britisheventing.com
- To qualify for the BE member fee riders must be current full members of BE. Horses do not have to be season ticket holders.
- Start fee of £4 per horse towards medical cover must be paid on collection of number. Subsequent entries per venue per horse will be charged at £2.
- Only entries on official BE JAS Entry Forms will be accepted. You may make additional entries on photocopies of an official JAS Entry Form to download forms www.britisheventing.com/JAS.
- Internet Entries preferred - entries can be made online at: www.britisheventing.com/JAS.
- Times available on www.britisheventing.com or from 18:00 on the date stated.
- Entries are on a first come, first accepted basis.
- The emphasis for JAS is on style not speed! The jumping speeds are set for Eventing so are not quick.
- Stabling: please book direct with the venue.
- Directions: please look on venue's website for location details or phone them direct.

2017 Rules

BAILEYS JUMPING & STYLE

1. Riders can compete HC in all classes except the Open sections.
2. Classes 2,4,5 (if eligible) and 6 are open to FEI ponies. Advanced riders may not compete in Class 1.
3. No refunds will be given after the close of entries.
4. Withdrawals and changes of horse/rider must be made by phone to Holly Farr or in writing to the secretary on the day of the competition.
5. The competition will consist of a Show Jumping round followed immediately by the timed Cross Country section. The show jumping starts with a bell and after the last show jump riders continue directly to the first cross country fence. The winner will be the horse with the lowest penalty score at the end of the competition. The penalty score will consist of: a style mark for the horse and rider judged by a BE Accredited Coach or elite rider over the Show Jumps and Cross Country fences and awarded out of 60 and converted to penalty marks. This will be added to the cross country time penalties and jumping penalties incurred during both phases as indicated below. The initial Show Jumping round will not be timed but jumping penalties will count.
6. Competitors must wear Cross Country colours and number bibs. Hats must comply with British Eventing standards and will be inspected and tagged if not previously approved. Body Protectors are recommended but not compulsory.
7. Competitors may compete in both classes at the same level and gain qualifications for championships. Horses may compete in no more than two classes per day. Dependant on number of entries in the championships, organisers reserve the right to move competitors with multiple rides into an open section or limit the number of horses ridden by a competitor if necessary.
8. Any objections must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the incident together with a deposit of £10.00. The decision of the British Eventing official will be final.
9. Classes will be run in accordance with British Eventing rules and qualifications except where specified and/or amended.
10. British Eventing reserves the right to alter or cancel any class it sees fit without giving a reason.
11. Prizes are awarded 1st to 3rd and thereafter ratio of 1 in 10. Rosettes to 6th place in qualifiers and 10th place in championships
12. British Eventing, its officials and the venue and its officials can accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any person or object at the event.
13. A minimum of 10 from each class will qualify for the Championships. Numbers will be confirmed on event web page.
14. In the event of equal scores, the competitor with the lower style mark will take the higher placing. If there is still an equal score, the competitor closest to the optimum time will take the higher placing.
15. There will be random vaccination record checks; failure to produce could result in the horse being unable to compete.
16. Two courses will be in use throughout the qualifiers, with a separate course for the Final.
17. A class will be full when entries reach 50 even if this is before the closing date, therefore entries are on a first-come, first-served basis. Competitors may enter open classes.
