

Summary of Falls on Cross Country Courses for 2011/12 Season

61,678 XC starters on 494 BE & FEI courses for UK competitions.

1,730 falls in total on the XC at Events, 1,622 occurred at a fence, 108 occurred on the flat.

Using the combined result from the above table, so using all the data collected, this gives us the following risk factors for the different types of fall:

Somersault horse fall	28%	risk of a serious/fatal outcome
Non-somersault horse fall	7%	risk of a serious/fatal outcome
Unseated rider fall	2%	risk of a serious/fatal outcome
